At that time I was the Head Coach of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers, and Frank was a rookie player that our scouts recommended we sign to a contract. As I got to spend time with Frank, I found out that he had come from a troubled past. All he needed, he told me, was another chance.

I believed in him, but those changes would be difficult and they wouldn't happen overnight. I gave him a chance to be on our team in Tampa, but it was God who really gave Frank a "second chance" at life. Over the next few years he got to see that you don't measure life by material things and that you only fool yourself when you chase the wrong things in life. While playing professional football once seemed to be the ultimate dream for him, he actually discovered that it doesn't profit a man anything to gain the whole world and forfeit his soul.

As I said, that growth didn't come instantly and Frank had to learn some hard lessons before he finally changed his lifestyle and committed his life totally to God. But there was always that good side to him—the side that made you root for him and really wish for him to succeed. With this book Frank is hoping to do the one thing he has always wanted to do and that's to help others. He wants to show people how God made a change in his life and helped him realize what it means to have the right priorities.

It's my hope that young people will read this book and be encouraged—not to follow the unstable path of chasing after the things much of our society says are important, but encouraged to chase the right dreams and follow the Lord's guidance. And encouraged to follow Frank Murphy's example of never giving up. I hope they will see, as Frank did, that it is only through Christ that they can reach their potential!




